SUBJECT: CTA – WETLAND IDENTIFIERS ON PRODUCER MAPS

Purpose. To provide information on a teleconference to explain the revised wetland symbols that will be displayed on producer's maps generated by the FSA Common Land Unit.

Background

National FSA Notice CP-614 provided information regarding new wetland identifier symbology that will now print on producer maps. Attached is a fact sheet that counties can provide to producers as part of the efforts to publicize the change in symbology. Also attached is a question and answer sheet that was developed during discussions with the farm groups on this topic. The question and answers can be utilized by the service center in responding to producer questions as well as providing them the fact sheet.
