SUBJECT: ECS – INVASIVE PLANT CONTROL JOB SHEETS

Purpose. To distribute newly developed job sheets

Expiration Date. September 30, 2007

Six new job sheets have been developed for interim conservation practice standard MN-797, Terrestrial Invasive Plant Species Pest Management. These job sheets are for specific invasive species and include a description of the plant, the ecological threat posed by these plants and detailed information on control methods that can be used. The six job sheets that have been developed to date are for the following plants:

- Japanese knotweed
- Black Swallow-Wort
- Grecian foxglove
- Common tansy
- Cut-leaved teasel
- Buckthorn

These job sheets have been posted on the Minnesota NRCS web site in the eFOTG, section IV D, Job Sheets. Job sheets for Canada thistle, Spotted knapweed and Leafy spurge are being developed and should be completed by May. Job sheets for additional species will be made available as they are completed.
