The National NRCS Publications and Forms Distribution Center - LANDCARE staff are members of the Legislative and Public Affairs Division under the State and Field Communications Branch. The National Volunteer Coordinator supervises the operation which utilizes the Caller Database to enter orders, approve web orders, ship orders and maintain inventory.

Telephone and fax orders are entered into the database within one business day of receipt. Web orders are approved within one business day of receipt. All orders are shipped within three business days.
