(practices: anaerobic digesters, waste facility covers)

(practices: diversion, grade stabilization structures, waterways, water and sediment control basins, dams).

_____ **FORREST MANAGEMENT**

(practices: forest harvest trails and landings, forest stand improvement, forest site preparation, tree/shrub establishment)

_____ **GRAZING**

(practices: prescribed grazing, grass plantings, fencing)

_____ **WATER RESOURCE PROTECTION**

(practices: nutrient mgt., well decommissioning, riparian forest buffer, filter strips, pest management, sinkhole treatment, use exclusion, contour buffer strips, field borders, irrigation water management, sediment basins, roof runoff structures, Ag Waste pits.)

_____ **WILDLIFE HABITAT IMPROVEMENT**

(practices: windbreaks, fish stream improvement, restoration of rare and declining habitat, upland wildlife habitat mgt.)
