





# Conservation Security Program

**March 2005**

**Stearns County, Minnesota**

The Conservation Security Program (CSP) signup has been announced for the Sauk watershed. Signup will be March 28 to May 27, 2005. Two meetings are scheduled to distribute and review required CSP certification worksheets to interested producers.



## How CSP Works

1. Signup will be a personal interview by appointment only at the NRCS office in Waite Park.
2. The blue self assessment workbooks distributed at the January CSP meetings are required for signup.
3. Certification worksheets are now available for the Sauk and are also required for an application.
4. Attend one of the two meetings listed below to pick up your CSP worksheets.
5. Review your records (soil and manure tests, etc.) and complete the worksheets.

6. Call the USDA Service Center at 320-251-7800 ext. 3 to make an appointment for a personal interview.

7. Bring your completed workbook and certification worksheets to the personal interview. Plan for a 1 to 2 hour interview.

Attend a meeting and pick up an application packet of certification worksheets. When your self assessment workbook and certification worksheets are complete, please call for a personal appointment. All applicants must make an appointment by May 27, 2005.
