## 2012 EQIP Signup

Minnesota Supplement for:  
Practice Standard 620 – Underground Outlet

### Supplemental Criteria

1. Horizontal drain lines are paid under practice 606, Subsurface Drain.
2. Payment for Underground Outlet is only authorized as a supporting practice for Terrace (600), Water and Sediment Control Basin (638), Diversion (362), Grassed Waterway (412), Subsurface Drain (606), and Roof Runoff Management (558).
3. Underground Outlet for Dike is eligible **ONLY** as a facilitating practice to Dike (356) and only in the Red River Valley as part of the Ring Dike Initiative.
4. Directional boring is authorized for boring an underground outlet only under a state, county, or township road or railroad. Size of pipe shall be 10 inch diameter minimum.
5. **Consult General Provision 15 for Ag Waste System payment cap information.**
