Minnesota Supplement for:
Practice Standard 634 – Waste Transfer

Supplemental Criteria

1. **Consult General Provision 15 for Ag Waste System payment cap information.**
2. Payment includes pumps and pipelines used to transfer manure or wastewater from a collection point to a storage or treatment area.
3. Waste Transfer (634) does not include collection facilities such as barn cleaners and flush systems. Buildings over reception pits or pumps are NOT eligible for Payment.
4. Waste Transfer (634) is a facilitating practice and MUST be installed in conjunction with an animal waste system.
5. Pumps for transfer of feedlot runoff or milking facility wash water are covered under Pumping Plant.
- i) Payment for Waste Transfer – Concrete Scrape Alley is authorized as a facilitating practice for animal waste systems.
 - a. Practice consists of a minimum scrape alley area of 12 sq.ft per 1n ft of alley. (i.e. A 10foot wide alley with 2 ft high curb; a 10 ft wide alley with two 1ft high curbs; 11 ft wide ally with 1ft high curb)
 - b. This practice is only applicable to alleys outside of barns.
6. Waste Transfer – Gravity includes payment for materials, equipment and labor needed to install a large diameter gravity pipe and a reception pit.
7. Waste Transfer – Pumped includes payment for materials, equipment and labor needed to install a piston pump or electric centrifugal slurry pump and pipeline pipe.
8. Wastewater pump payment includes pumps, controls, mounting rails, and electrical hookup after the service panel. Tanks and pipelines are covered under separate items.
