

Local Work Group development of local EQIP.

Mille Lacs County NRCS, District FY03 EQIP

1. *List the local resource concerns that EQIP can address:*

The local work group for Mille Lacs County identified water quality as the most important resource concern. EQIP can address this broad category by addressing the following conservation practices: wildlife habitat, agricultural waste and runoff, and prescribed grazing. Secondary concerns of the group were forest management, soil erosion, wetland restoration, and critical wildlife habitat.

2. *If applicable, list any geographic regions (i.e. watersheds, townships, etc.) and their respective resource concerns within the District to receive priority:*

Resource concerns that the LWG would like to have EQIP address as high priority would be a 150 foot buffer around DNR identified protected waters. The LWG felt that in addition to being in this geographic region, a conservation practice would need to be installed to improve an environmental concern.

G Grazing System	Medium-High	7
H Forest Mgt.	Medium	6
Additional Local*	High	10
