In Lac Qui Parle and Yellow Medicine Watershed priority areas and resource concern was water quality and soil erosion. Lac Qui Parle is highlighted in pink and the Yellow Medicine Watershed is highlighted in blue.

The local EQIP program description, cost-share docket changes, and ranking worksheet must be reviewed and approved by the State Conservationist before any EQIP contract is approved and signed.


