

# Local Work Group development of local EQIP.

## Blue Earth County Soil and Water Conservation District FY06 EQIP

1. List the local resource concerns that EQIP can address:

**1. Soil quality-excessive sheet/rill and other erosion. 2. Surface water quality-nutrients, pesticides, sedimentation, animal wastes, loss of riparian vegetation, loss of wetlands, streambank stabilization. 3. Air quality. 4. Water quantity-flooding/excess surface water. 5. Grazing systems. 6. Conservation Crop rotation. 7. Wildlife Habitat.**

2. If applicable, list any geographic regions (i.e. watersheds, townships, etc.) and their respective resource concerns within the District to receive priority:

**Maple River Watershed, the Townships of Lime and Jamestown, Le Sueur Watershed, and other TMDL area's.**

\* If the additional local concern is scored, describe the concern here and how points will be scored. Include any geographic priorities. **EQIP contracts of practices 328, 329, 512, 528A, 590, 595 and a buffer practice receives 6 points. EQIP contracts in the Maple River, Le Sueur, Middle Minnesota watersheds receives 6 points. EQIP contracts in the above mentioned townships receive 6 points. EQIP contracts with the CORE 6 practices and located in the Maple River, Le Sueur and other TMDL Area's receive 6 points.**
